Eligibility

- 15 20 years attending any school in Tanzania
- Aspiration to join career pathways in the Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM) and other fields, demonstrated through school projects, clubs or other internships
- Strong work ethic, communication and collaboration skills
- Proficiency in the English language

Application

Prospective candidates are required to fill in the application form fully and thoughtfully to be considered for the internship program. Candidates will be required to answer a series of questions about their interest in the internship program and rank their top 4 internship positions. Applications are due by Wednesday, 28th May 2025.

Selection Process



All shortlisted candidates from the initial internship screening will receive free interview training provided by UpStudio Africa. Please note: All students will interview with the UpStudio Africa team as part of the final selection process. Interviews with corporate partners are not required for every candidate and will be arranged based on specific placement needs.



TOYOTA

Toyota Tanzania has been the exclusive distributor of Toyota vehicles in Tanzania since 1965, providing a wide selection of brand-new vehicles and now, pre-owned vehicles under AUTOMARK. InnovateX Interns at Toyota explore the world of mechanical engineering at the Pugu Road Showroom.

- A maximum of 3 Interns will be selected for the Toyota Tanzania Internship.
- Internship starts on Monday, June 30 for a period of 3 4 weeks depending on the availability of InnovateX interns.
- InnovateX students are required to attend an event on Monday, July 28 with Toyota Tanzania.

Mechanical Engineering Team

- Undergo training program covering car mechanics and safety measures in the workshop.
- Interactive sessions with automobile engineers and technicians.
- Support maintenance of all vehicles, including but not limited to hybridelectric cars, luxury SUV, pick-ups, and compact vehicles.
- Support in refurbishing preowned vehicles and gain exposure to the supply chain.

The fieldwork would take into account all safety and security requirements set out by Toyota Tanzania and UpStudio Africa. A Tsh 70,000 fee is required to cover the cost of Personal Protective Equipment. This fee is payable directly to suppliers of the PPE through Toyota Tanzania.

- Sales & Marketing: Research potential brands to partner with in Europe and the US with aligned missions as Kazi Yetu. Furthermore, propose potential collaboration ideas for brand partnerships and support social media content photo and video shoots.

 Support the Business Operations team with administrative tasks and process development.

The InnovateX Internship Training Program is mandatory. This training costs Tsh. 300,000. This payment is made once you are selected in the program and is non-refundable. Payment details will be shared upon selection.

Disclaimer

The Corporate Partners do not receive any fees from UpStudio Africa for hosting and training the intern. The Corporate Partners are also not required to give any stipends to the interns. Interns are responsible for their own transportation and food costs during the internship.
